























Apramo Ostara Group 2-3 Car Seat

Thank you for purchasing this Group 2-3 car seat. If you are not completely satisfied with the car seat or you would like to change any accessory or obtain any help about the car seat, you can contact our customer services department (details on the back of this guide).

Please Note: Only suitable for use in vehicles fitted with a 3 point retractable safety belt approved to ECE R16 or equivalent standard (1).

General Safety Instructions

Keep these instructions with the car seat in case you need to refer to them again in the future. Failure to follow these instructions may affect your child's safety.

Your car seat must be positioned and installed so that, under normal vehicle usage conditions, no part can become jammed under or between any moveable seat or in the vehicle door:

Always replace the Ostara car seat after any accident, in case of any unseen damage.

Do not modify or add to your car seat in any way without the approval of a competent authority or the manufacturer, as this will void any warranty.

Shade your car seat from sunlight to avoid hot items causing injury to your child.

Do not leave your child unattended when in the car seat and in the vehicle.



Make sure there is no loose luggage or other large objects that are likely to cause injuries in the event of an accident. These may cause injury to other occupants. Always secure loose items.

Do not use the car seat without the seat cover. Do not replace the seat cover with any cover other than the one recommended by the manufacturer, as it directly influences the safety performance of the car seat.

Always ensure that the vehicle adult seat belt is fastened once your seat is installed. Secure your car seat with the vehicle seat belt at all times, even when not in use. An unsecured car seat can cause injuries in the event of a collision.

The car seat may acquire some wear and tear over the years, this will result in parts requiring replacement, please contact our customer service department for replacement parts.



Preparing your Ostara Car Seat for use

Before using your new Ostara Car Seat it is important to understand fully how to install your car seat properly, secure your child correctly and familiarize yourself with the features and functions of the seat.

Please take the time to read and understand these instructions fully. This is best done with the seat in front of you.

Please always read the safety warnings.

Assemble your Car Seat

Only refer to this section if your car seat is supplied with the backrest separated from the base.

At the base end of the backrest you will find two projecting tabs. Align and engage both tabs with the openings found at the rear of the seat base (4) (5), then you need to raise the backrest up vertical.



To raise the backrest, push the lower section of the backrest down while pulling the top of the headrest forward (6) until you hear and feel a 'click', make sure the tabs are fully inserted into the openings and the backrest feels secure and stable.

Adjusting the Headrest

The child's head should sit directly in the middle of the headrest and the sides of the headrest should sit just above the child's shoulders (7).

To adjust the headnest to the connect height for your child, first put one hand on the top of the backnest, then grip the plastic panel at the back of the headnest and pull outwards to move the headnest up or down (8).

Ensure the headrest is fixed by pulling the headrest up and down ensuring the panel locks into the next stop position.



Installing the Car Seat into a Vehicle

The seat can be used for a child 3 years to 12 years securing the child with the adult seat belt.

Please Note: Your car seat is designed to fit only with a 3 point lap and diagonal seat belt and must not at any time be fitted using only a 2 point lap belt (1).

Securing the Child in the Car Seat with the Adult Belt

Place the car seat against the backrest of the vehicle seat (9).

Check that the headrest of the vehicle seat does not obstruct the car seat. If this should be the case then adjust or remove the vehicle headrest.

With your child sitting upright and back in the seat, extract the adult seat belt and pass it across the front of the child.



Pass the lap section of the adult belt over the child's lap and under the armnest on both sides of the seat. Ensure the lap belt is low down on the child's lap and firmly engaging with the pelvis. Connect the adult belt connector tongue to the seat belt buckle (10).

Locate the upper portion of the diagonal section of the adult belt into the diagonal shoulder belt guide located on the underneath of the headrest (11).

Ensure that on the buckle side both the lap and diagonal sections of the adult seat belt pass under the armrest (12).

To remove your child from the car seat, simply unbuckle the seat belt and place it at the side of the car seat. The belt will remain suspended from the diagonal shoulder belt guide.



Final Checklist

However safe a child seat is, however well built it is, your child's safety depends on you carrying out the following checks before every journey.

- Check the car seat is facing forwards in the vehicle and in the direction of travel (9).
- Check the adult seat belt is fitted correctly with the lap section under the armrest and the diagonal under the armrest on the buckle side (12).
- Check the upper diagonal section is located in the diagonal shoulder belt guide underneath the headrest (11).
- Check the vehicle seat belt is not twisted or slack.
- Check the head rest position is at the correct height (7) (8).

IMPORTANT: Misusing your child seat will reduce the protection and safety you offer your child.



Maintenance

The car seat cover is removable. In case of light staining, clean using a damp cloth or soapy water. The cover can be removed completely and hand washed up to 30°c.

Removing the Cover

Unassemble the seat base from the backrest by pushing down on the seat base whilst pushing the backrest backwards until the two projecting tabs on the backrest disconnect with the openings in the seat base.

Now remove the covers from the seat base by pulling it off over the back of the seat.



Remove the cover from the backrest by first unhooking the elastic sections around the projecting tabs, then unattach the velcro strips on the cover; pull the cover off over the side wings and remove from the backrest shell.

Unhook the elastic sections under the shoulder sections of the headrest and pull the headrest cover up over the top of the headrest shell.

Additional Information

This car seat is not approved for use on aircraft. For more information contact the airline.
